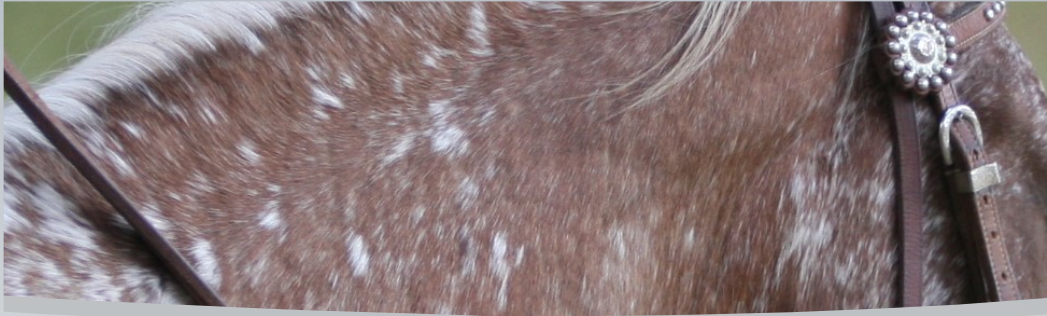

Dear horse friend

The Appaloosa belongs to the 3 most popular American horse breeds with currently around 650'000 registered horses all over the world. The Appaloosa has roots dating back to the Nez Perce Indians who were the only tribe that already carried on the breeding of horses by carefully considering the same criteria horse breeders account for today. Appaloosas are known the world over for their unique coat patterns, for their strength, speed, power of endurance and athletic ability and for their intelligence.

In 1938 the Appaloosa Horse Club — a sport and breeding association — was founded in Moscow (Idaho) aiming to promote and spread Appaloosa horses. Since then affiliate associations have been founded in many countries all over the world. The affiliates pursue the same goals, principles and rules within their borders as the head quarter in Moscow does.

We — the Appaloosa Horse Club Switzerland — are the smallest European affiliate with currently around 90 members. Nevertheless we dare again a project with international importance: the organization of the European Championship for Appaloosas.

With more than 100 horses and 450 entries, this competition is going to be the biggest European event of our breed. Along competitors from Germany, Austria, France, Italy and Switzerland also participants from Netherlands, Denmark, Sweden, Belgium, Czech Republic, Great Britain and Spain are expected to join. Since 4 years we successfully organize the European Championships and are looking forward to this challenge this year.

The **European Championship** is held from October 8th - 11th, 2015 in Mooslargue (F) at the famous HorseAcademy facility close to the city of Basel (CH). In addition to many active volunteers we rely on financial support – it is impossible to perform such an event without any sponsors. The aid money will be exclusively used for this event.

Information about the Show

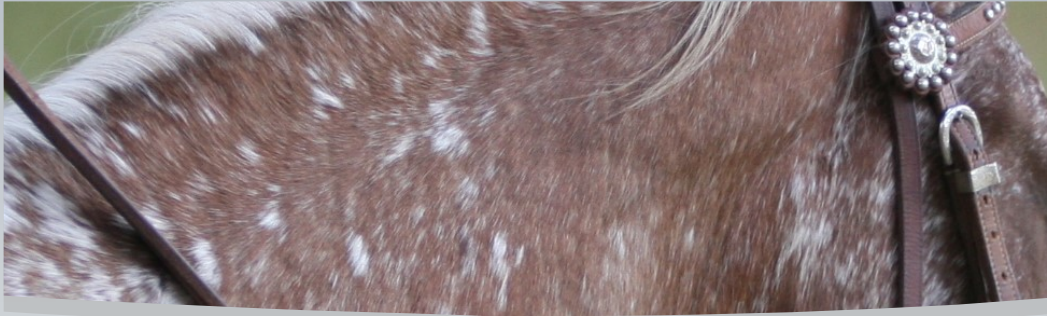
In this show, horse and rider primarily compete for World Show qualification points allowing them to participate in the biggest Appaloosa event held every year in Fort Worth (Texas).

The European Championship is called a 4-pointed competition which means that the event is simultaneously judged by 4 judges. In order to assure the independency between participants and judges, we do not oblige European but American judges.

Depending on the age of horse and rider, different classes are offered.

The best 8 horse-rider-combinations receive an imprinted ribbon. In addition the best 3 horse-rider-combinations get an engraved medal. And before the national anthem is played, the winning horse gets an imprinted sash put on around it's neck.





The Disciplines



Halter

In Halter classes, horses are presented from the ground and are — segregated by sex and age — assessed according to conformation, exterior and expression



Most Colorful At Halter

In this class the horse with the most extraordinary coat pattern and body is elected independent of sex and age.



Showmanship (Western and English)

Here, the exhibitor is evaluated according to his ability to perform a given sequence of maneuvers from the ground. Presence, body tension, control about every movement and precision are required.



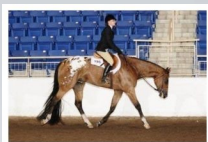
Trail

In this course, the rider has to navigate his horse precisely through several obstacles such as poles, bridges and gates and in the given gait.



Western Pleasure

Here, the horse wins that seems to be the most comfortable in every gait. The horse is expected to perform on a slack rein and to show smooth movements.



Hunter under Saddle

In order to demonstrate the versatility of the breed, horses are as well shown in the English manner of riding. Akin to pleasure except that another type of horse and movement is rewarded.



Western Riding

In Western Riding the horse is expected to perform many precise and smooth flying lead changes on loose reins.



Equitation (Western and English)

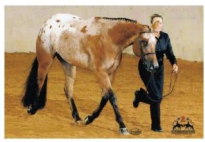
This discipline is also called horsemanship since the rider is judged according to his seat and preferably invisible cues.



Longe Line

The one, two or three year-old horses are shown in walk, jog and lope on a longe on both sides. The qualities of gaits are assessed with regard to their later eligibility as a pleasure horse.





Hunter in Hand

The exhibitor presents the horse in English headstall and attire in walk and trot. Movement, conformation and temperament of the horse are evaluated with regard to its suitability for halter classes.



Reining

Among all western disciplines the only FEI discipline. Contestants are required to run an approved pattern divided into 7 or eight spectacular manoeuvres such as sliding stops, spins or roll backs.



Heritage

Since the Appaloosa is rich in history, this class is designed to vividly portray some of this history. The class is judged on authenticity of trappings and equipment.



Working Cowhorse

This cow discipline consists of two parts. In the first part the athletic ability of the ranch horse type is shown by performing a reining pattern without any cow (thus also referred to „Dry Work“). In the second part (the „Fence Work“), the rider is expected to keep the cow at the short fence of the arena (called boxing) before he has to turn and circle the cow on both sides.

Hunter Hack

Appaloosa horses are very versatile. The Hunter Hack class demonstrates this in an impressive way, where jumps of almost a meter has to be performed in a relaxed and comparative manner.



Pleasure Driving

This class is designed to depict the early American or Frontier age of which the Appaloosa was a part and shall depict the usefulness of the Appaloosa as a family horse used for pleasure driving.



Cutting

In this discipline, a cow has to be separated from the herd and prevented to return to it's herd. By doing so, the horse shall work absolutely independent. All necessary cues given by the rider are penalized.
